What is the event?

On May 23 and 24, we will gather in Ottawa to set a course for the beginning of the end of the Indian Act. This two-day summit will bring together thinkers and leaders to engage participants in an innovative dialogue on the road to decolonization.

What barriers stand in our way? What should this new nation-to-nation relationship look like? This partnership with Osgoode Law School, will seek to answer questions such as these through an Indigenous-led discourse.

The event will feature a broad range of voices including Indigenous youth, women, leaders, Elders, legal experts, scholars, and keepers of traditional Indigenous knowledge, working in collaboration with government stakeholders to create a plan of action. This two day summit will attract over 250 participants who will shape and construct what a new nation-to-nation relationship looks like.

Why is this needed?

We need to address the crises threatening the wellbeing of Indigenous communities. By restructuring and decolonizing the relationship between Indigenous Peoples and government, we can move forward together.

The evolution of Indigenous self-government will be a premise of a Canada Without the Indian Act, replaced by a Nation-to-Nation relationship. We will create a plan of action to reach our goal of ending the colonial legacy of the Indian Act.

Participants of **determiNATION** will mount the framework for change from an Indigenous perspective. Indigenous Peoples will engage with government and public service representatives in co-creating new, practical solutions.

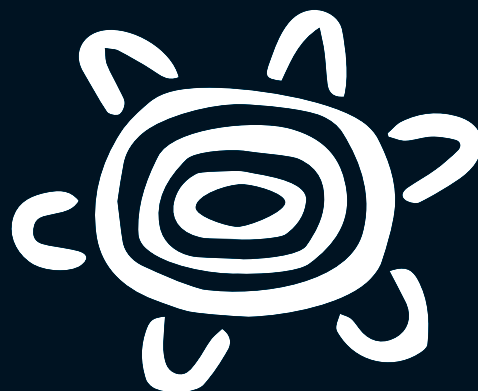
